SOUTH OF MOROCCO

While traveling along the arid roads and tracks of southern Morocco, you will visit the iconic and centuries-old kasbahs of the great Moroccan south. After passing through lush valleys filled with palm groves, famous for their dates that are renowned far beyond Morocco's borders, you will reach the gateway to the vast Sahara Desert. You will have the privilege of spending a night in the desert after a camel ride to your bivouac.

Duration of the trip: 08 days / 07 nights **Theme:** Discovering the Moroccan desert















DAY 1





MARRAKECH

Arrival at Marrakech airport. Reception and assistance. Transfer to the hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 2





ZAGOR/

MARRAKECH – OUARZAZATE - ZAGORA

Breakfast.

Departure for Ouarzazate by the Tizi-n-Tichka pass road (2260 m) through the High Atlas. Fabulous mountain landscapes, terraced crops and Berber villages mark the route.. We continue to the UNESCO-restored Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou, which stands out as an exquisite example of how to take care of one's heritage with style. This Berber village, which deserves the title as the most impressive ksar of Morocco, has experienced virtually no change since the Middle Ages.





M'HAMID



OUARZAZATE - ERG EL IHOUDI - M'HAMID

Morning visit to the village of Tamegroute, home to a historic Quranic school library with over 4,000 ancient volumes, including an 11th-century Quran written on gazelle skin.

Continue to the Tinfou dunes, then take the track through Erg El Ihoudi (Jewish Dunes), located 9 km from M'Hamid.

Free lunch in Ouled Driss.

Afternoon camel ride to explore the M'Hamid palm grove. Dinner and overnight in M'Hamid.









M'HAMID – DUNE OF CHEGAGA

Departure to the real desert with its arid tracks, arriving at the massive dunes of Erg Chegaga, the largest in Morocco.

Free lunch at the foot of the dunes.

The palm groves of the Oued Draa gradually give way to dunes, forming Morocco's most impressive desert landscape.

Optional camel ride across the dunes of Chegaga (€30 per person).

Dinner and overnight in a nomadic tent camp





DAY 5



TAZENAKHT

Chegaga – Lake Iriqui – Foum Zguid – Taliouine

After a magical night, resume the journey, crossing the dry lake of Iriqui before reaching Foum Zguid, the first town after the desert.

Rest in the shaded oasis of Foum Zguid.

Free lunch, then depart for Tazenakht, a village famous for its handmade Berber carpets then continuation to Taliouine Capital of the Sfran.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 6



MARRAKECH

Taliouine – Aoulouz – Tizi n'Test – Asni – Marrakech

Early departure to enjoy the stunning Tizi n'Test Pass with a stop in Aoulouz. Free lunch, then continue towards Marrakech via Asni, a Berber village located 47 km from Marrakech at 1,150 meters altitude at the foot of Mount Toubkal. The panoramic view here is breathtaking, and Asni serves as a perfect starting

point for beautiful hikes.

Continue to Marrakech.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



MARRAKECH



Breakfast followed by a guided tour of the Red City:

Majorelle Gardens (botanical garden created by French painter Jacques Majorelle).

Bahia Palace, a masterpiece of Moroccan architecture with its beautiful gardens and patios.

Stop in front of the Koutoubia Mosque, an example of Almohad art.

Lunch at the hotel.

Visit to Jemaa El Fna Square, Marrakech's most famous square, recognized as a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage site.

Explore the souks.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 8

DEPARTUE
