Morning dedicated to the historical tour of Marrakech: the Koutoubia Mosque, the Bahia Palace, a necropolis adjoining the Kasbah Mosque and housing the tombs of the Saadian sultans and their relatives. Free lunch. In the afternoon, visit the medina and its various neighborhoods to admire local crafts in the souks. At the end of the day, the famous Jamaa El Fana Square, the most famous square in Morocco, offers a popular spectacle that should be attended to appreciate its value. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

MARRAKECH – TIZI N TEST - TAROUDANT

Route on the foothills of Toubkal to the Tizi-n-Test pass, a remarkable viewpoint overlooking the plain at an altitude of over 2000 m. This beautiful mountain road leads to the Tin-Mal Mosque, a former vestige of the Almohad dynasty, built in the 14th century and now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Free lunch and continuation to Taroudant. Also called "Little Marrakech". Dinner and overnight at the hotel

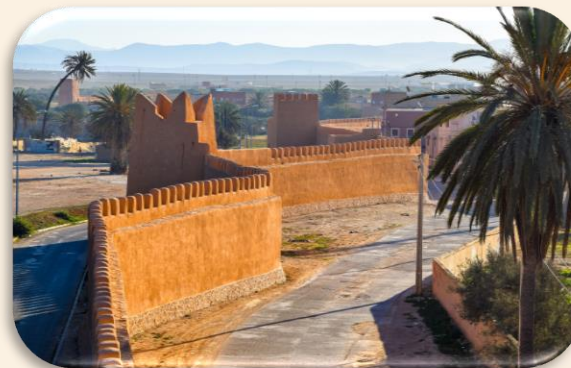
**TAROUDANT – TAFRAOUT VIA AIT BAHA
COL DU KERDOUS**

Departure via a beautiful mountain road to reach Tafraout, an exceptional site surrounded by almond trees, offering one of the most extraordinary landscapes in Morocco. Free time for lunch. Continue to the Kerdous Pass, the kingdom of the argan trees, through gigantic granite blocks. From the top of the pass (at 1100 m) the view is magnificent. Dinner and overnight at the hotel

DAY 5

COL DU KERDOUS – TIZNIT – MASSA - AGADIR

After breakfast, descend the pass by the winding road, which offers a spectacular view of the villages of the valley and the steppe of Tiznit, a landscape dotted with terraced crops and pink villages. Behind its imposing pink ochre walls, Tiznit hides a medina whose visit will allow you to discover its renowned crafts, in particular Berber jewelry and silver work. Continue to the Oued Massa National Park, a nature reserve of nearly 34,000 hectares, where wild boars, jackals, gazelles and many species of migratory or resident birds live side by side, including the Bald Ibis, a rare bird, endangered, seen only in two places in the world. Lunch in Massa. Free time. In the afternoon, drive to Agadir. Dinner and overnight at the hotel

AGADIR - ESSOUIRA

Visite d'Agadir: Le port, les vestiges de la kasbah, les seuls de l'ancienne Agadir et départ vers Essaouira pour un trajet très agréable : outre les "chèvres volantes" accrochées aux arganiers, les plus beaux panoramas de la côte atlantique s'offrent à vous. Dejeuner libre. Arrivée à Essaouira, cite attachante connue dès de la 14^{ème} siècle, sous le nom de Mogador .déjeuner. C'est la station balnéaire la plus agréable et la plus belle de la côte atlantique. Derrière ses murailles roses. Sur une presqu'île rocheuse. L'ancienne Mogador des Portugais est un "véritable fragment" d'Espagne au cœur du Maroc une ville blanche d'une luminosité. Découverte de la médina à pied. Diner et logement à l'hôtel
