Day 01 ARRIVE DELHI

Arrive at Delhi international airport, meet – greet with our office representative & transfer to your pre booked hotel. Once you will reach your hotel our representative will handover you the travel documents and explain your entire plan in details.



Delhi, City of Djinns, and 25 million people. Like an eastern Rome, India's capital is littered with the relics of lost empires. A succession of armies stormed across the Indo-Gangetic plain and imprinted their identity onto the vanquished city, before vanishing into rubble and ruin like the conquerors who preceded them. Modern Delhi is a chaotic tapestry of medieval fortifications, Mughal mausoleums, dusty bazaars, colonial-era town planning, and mega malls.

Day 02 DELHI

Morning after breakfast drive for sightseeing tour of Old Delhi; visit Jama Masjid; the largest



mosque of India build by Shah Jahan, after that proceed to take pictures of Red Fort, after words Rickshaw ride in Chandni Chock (old Bazaar) one of the oldest and busiest markets in Old Delhi, built in the 17th century by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan and designed by his daughter Jahan Ara and visit Shish Gung Gurudwara.

On a way back to visit the Raj Ghat; the black marble platform where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated in 1948 AD.

Later enjoy walking around Lutyens Delhi to take pictures of beautiful building of British era; the Presidential House, Parliament and India Gate; the memorial bears the name of more than 13516 British and Indian soldiers killed in the 1st World War near the frontier of Afghan in 1919 AD, it was build in 1921 AD.

Late afternoon sightseeing of New Delhi; visit Qutub-Minar; the red and buff sandstone is the highest tower in India. It has a diameter of 14.32 m at the base and about 2.75 m on the top with a height of 72.5 m. The tall minaret was constructed in 1192 by Qutab-ud-din Aibak, and later completed by his successor Iltutmish.

Day 03 DELHI / JAIPUR

Morning after breakfast drive by surface to Jaipur (270 kms / 6 hrs).



Jaipur, the 'Pink City', has been the capital of erstwhile Jaipur state since its inception in 1727 AD, It was founded by Sawai Jai Singh II, a great ruler as well as renowned mathematician and astrologer. Vidhyadhar Bhattacharya, designed Jaipur as per the Hindu treatise, Shilp Shashtra. In 1876 Jaipur dressed itself in pink to welcome Prince Albert, consort of queen Victoria, and earned the epitaph 'Pink City'.

Afternoon arrive and check-into hotel.

Late afternoon, proceed to visit **Nahargarh Fort**. Nahargarh Fort was built in the 18th Century on the hilltops of Jaipur alongside Amber and Jaigarh to provide a defensive retreat.

In English, Nahargarh means the "abode of tigers". The extremely long access road winds up from the city and the walls seem to go as far as the eye can see, joining up with Amber and Jaigarh Forts to create a very impressive blockade. Nahargarh Fort was never attacked in its entire history.

Evening, enjoy a mesmerizing sunset along with Tea Coffee at the Café in the Fort Courtyard. Return back to Hotel for overnight stay.

Day 04 JAIPUR



Morning after breakfast drive to visit Amber Fort (11 kms away from city), Amer, originally, was the capital of the state before Jaipur. It is an old fort, built in 1592 by Raja Man Singh. To reach the hill top enjoy the elephant ride.

On a way back photo stop at Jal Mahal (water Palace) to take the beautiful pictures.



Afternoon sightseeing tour of Pink city visit the City Palace & museum; the complex lies at the heart of the city. Getting in is simpler than it once was. At the heart of the complex is seven-tiered Chandra Mahal where the erstwhile royal family is still in residence, though only a small part of the apartments are occupied. However, it is only the buildings around Chandra Mahal that are open to the public, and these also form part of a museum which includes

everything from Grand outfits (including one with 18 kilos of golden thread woven into it) to swords and two silver urns that are believed to be the largest silver objects in the world.

Visit Jantar Mantar; a stone observatory, part of the city palace complex, Jantar Mantar is one of several other astronomical observatories created by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II. These concrete masonry instruments were used to measure everything from altitude to time, and map the movement of the planets and the stars.



After that we take you to the Hawa Mahal (the Palace of the winds) for exterior view and beautiful pictures. Hawa Mahal consists of five tiers of corridors on the inside, with pierced screen windows of 956, which overlook the street below. It is believed the women of the royal zenana would sit concealed behind these screens to see life in the city beyond the walls of the palace.

Return back to Hotel.

Day 05 JAIPUR / FATEHPUR SIKRI / AGRA

Morning after breakfast drive by surface to Agra (260 kms / 5 hrs).



En route visit Fatehpur Sikri - the extraordinary city built by Akbar the Great, deserted 14 years later, but which, during its brief span, exceeded London in both grandeur and population. After visit continue drive to Agra.

Agra is a city on the banks of the river Yamuna- the city of Agra is synonymous with the Taj Mahal-one of the Seven Wonders of the World, renowned for its beauty and historical significance. Apart from being an important capital city to the Mughals during their rule, Agra also finds mention in the ancient Hindu scripture of Mahabharata, where it was called Agrevana- which meant "The Border of the Forest". It is believed that the city was founded by Raja Badal Singh, a Rajput king, who's fort Badalgarh, stood on or near the present city.



Noon arrive and check-into hotel.

Later visit the Red Fort built by three generations of Mughal emperors, between 1565 and 1573. It housed both the residential palaces of the Royal family and the military quarters.

Overnight stay at hotel

Day 06 AGRA / DELHI (210 Kms / 4 Hrs)



Early morning Sunrise visit of the world famous Taj Mahal a monument of love built by Shah Jahan as a memorial for his wife, Mumtaz Mahal, an incredible 20,000 workman's labored on it, day and night. The construction of the Taj Complex began about 1631 AD. The principal mausoleum was completed in 1648 AD by employing thousands of artisans and craftsmen, whereas, the outlying buildings and gardens were finished five years later in 1653 AD.

Return back to hotel for breakfast.

After a leisurely breakfast drive back to Delhi (205 kms / 3 hrs).

Late afternoon arrive Delhi and free for own activities or last minute shopping.

Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 07 DELHI – GOA (By Flight)

Breakfast at Hotel.

In time, transfer to airport to board flight for Goa.

Proceed for half day tour of Old Goa. Very near to Panaji city, the modern capitol of Goa, you will visit Old Goa or Velha Goa and witness its rich history and heritage. Between the 16th and 18th centuries, what is now Old Goa, used to be bigger than London and Lisbon. The city was called the Rome of the East because of its impressive cathedrals, churches, towers, and other structures.

You can still see that grandeur today. See the **Basilica of Bom Jesus**, the tomb of St. Francis Xavier, **Se Cathedral**, church of St. Cajetan, and the Viceroy Arch. Many of them are still in use and are **UNESCO** Heritage sites.

Later drive to the capital of Goa – Panaji City, walk along the **Latin Quarter** of Goa, **Mala Fountainhas** and later see the pious **Mary Immaculate church** in City Square and finally end the tour by exploring the local market of Panaji.
