Bahia Palace, a masterpiece of Moroccan architecture with its gardens and courtyards.

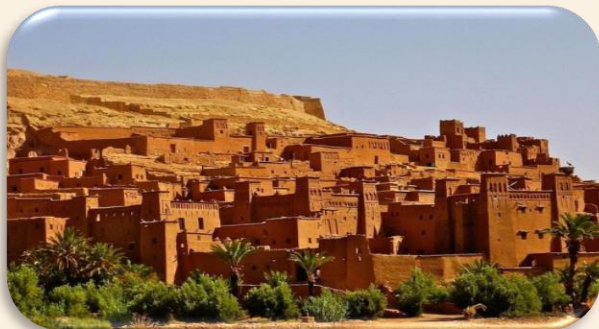
Free time for lunch

After breakfast, meet at the hotel lobby at 7:00 am to pick up the car, departure for Ouarzazate. Between Marrakech and Ouarzazate, a winding road winds through the High Atlas Mountains, offering breathtaking landscapes of mountains of all colors, picturesque villages, green palm groves and century-old Kasbahs. Crossing the Tizi-n-tichkale pass, the highest point of the road between Marrakech and Ouarzazate, culminating at 2260m. Departure for the Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou, a magnificent Ksar classified as a UNESCO heritage site that has been the subject of many film shoots. Free lunch. Afternoon, continue to Ouarzazate. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Breakfast. **Optional Zagora excursion.** The road winds its way into the Jbel Tifernine before beginning an impressive descent towards the Draa Valley. Not far from the Jbel Zagora. The secular religious center of Tamegroute houses a library of the Koranic school which is rich in more than 4,000 volumes, including a Koran written on gazelle skin dating from the 11th century. Free lunch. Return to Ouarzazate. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

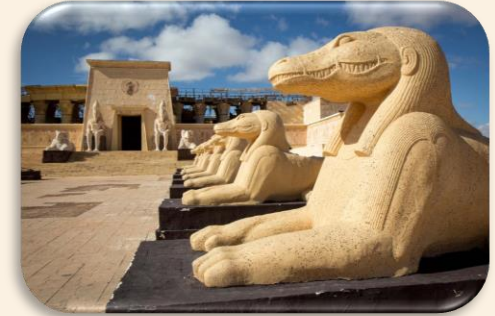
Breakfast. **Optional excursion:** towards the verdant Tinghir by the track to Boumalne. Arrival at Kelaa Mgouna a large village located at an altitude of 1,450 m. It is located at the junction of the M'Goun and Dades valleys. The region is famous for its rose which blooms every year from mid-April to mid-May. A festival celebrates it at the beginning of May for three days. El-Kelaa des M'Gouna also houses one of the harshest prisons in the kingdom. 15 km from the city of Tinghir, the Todra Gorges offer tourists and travelers many opportunities for walking, hiking and climbing. Free lunch in the middle of this famous setting then return to Ouarzazate. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Breakfast. Departure for Marrakech via the Tizi-n-Tichka pass, through the High Atlas. Free lunch. Arrival and installation at the hotel. Free afternoon. Dinner and night at the hotel.

Breakfast. Optional Excursion Essaouira. After breakfast. Departure for ESSAOUIRA "the old Mogador". this port and tourist city located on the Atlantic coast of Morocco. On the seaside, its medina (old town) is protected by 18th century ramparts, called the Skala de la Kasbah and designed by European engineers. Dotted with old copper cannons, the fortifications offer a view of the ocean. With their powerful trade winds, the city's beaches are ideal for surfing, windsurfing and kitesurfing. Free lunch. Return to Marrakech. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.
